



Undergraduate Field Attachment Announcement: One Health Demo site 2021 Cohort

The USAID One Health Workforce - Next Generation (OHW-NG) project, in collaboration with AFROHUN Kenya, invites current undergraduate students in Student One Health Innovation Clubs (SOHICs.) to the One Health Demonstration site 2021.

Registration Deadline: 9TH July 2021 (11.59pm EAT)

DEMONSTRATION SITES

The One Health Demo Site Field Attachment is a multidisciplinary, experiential training in community engagement concerning assessment of infectious disease threats. As part of the program, successful applicants will attend mandatory theoretical classes from 26th -31st July 2021, followed by a field attachment from the 2nd -13th August 2021. Students will carry out One Health Field activities which will involve site visits, community education, awareness campaigns, home visits, etc in surrounding areas within Loitokitok, Kajiado County. The students will present their findings to the relevant stakeholders and the university thereafter.

Funding & Support

Participants will be supported with internet to enable them to complete the on-line theoretical classes. This first week (26th -31st July 2021) program is non-residential and is geared towards orientation ahead of the field training, however **all field activities will be residential**.

Target participants

The applicants targeted are current University of Nairobi, Moi University and Maasai Mara University undergraduate students. Interested applicants should have a great potential for leadership, ability to work in multi-disciplinary teams and a vested interest in advancing the emerging field of One Health.

Participants are highly encouraged to have taken a COVID 19 vaccine or be willing to take COVID 19 test 72 hrs. before commencement of the field attachment.

Who should apply?

- Current Undergraduate students from One Health Institutions (University of Nairobi, Moi University & Maasai Mara University) in Kenya
- The fields of Social Sciences, Public Health, Mass Communication, IT, Veterinary, Nursing, Law, Human Medicine, Human Nutrition, Agriculture, Environment, Business, Laboratory Sciences, psychology Education, Performing Arts, Law, and other Health Sciences.
- Fluent in English communication (listening, speaking, writing, and understanding).
- A recommendation from his/her academic supervisor.
- Fully available for the on-line theoretical training from **26th -31st July 2021** and thereafter for a Field Attachment from **2nd -13th August 2021**.
- Should have fulltime access to a laptop or a smart phone.

Application Procedure

All applications must be written in English according to the guidelines indicated on the application form and should be submitted by 9th July 2021. Applicants are required to fill in and submit their application through the form in the link:
